



Preventative healthcare for your pet

Vaccination

Dogs:

1st vaccination from 6 weeks of age, 2nd vaccination from 10 weeks of age (must have an interval of 3-4 weeks between vaccinations). To maintain cover dogs will need yearly booster vaccinations. Dogs are protected against Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvovirus, Parainfluenza and Leptospirosis.

Puppies vaccinated at Summerhill are legible to join our puppy parties (a 4 week training and socialisation course with other puppies of the same age), and are given 4 weeks free insurance. At 6 months old they can join our youth club and receive a 20 minute complete health examination and assessment from the practice nurse free of charge. All dogs that receive boosters are legible to join our well pet clubs; the nurse will assess your dog and give advice on weight, neutering and preventative care as required; these 20 minute appointments are free of charge and are scheduled for 6 months after the booster vaccination is given thus ensuring your pet has a thorough assessment every 6 months. Dogs can be protected against kennel cough with an intranasal vaccine; this provides protection for 12 months.

Cats:

1st vaccination from 9 weeks of age, 2nd vaccination from 12 weeks (must have an interval of 3-4 weeks between vaccinations). To maintain cover cats will need yearly booster vaccinations. Cats are protected against Cat flu, enteritis, panleucopaenia, and feline leukaemia virus.

Kittens vaccinated at Summerhill are legible for 4 weeks free insurance. At 6 months old they can join our youth club and receive a 20 minute complete health examination and assessment from the practice nurse free of charge. All cats that receive boosters are legible to join our well pet clubs in line with the feline advisory bureau and will receive free of charge well cat logs from the practice; the nurse will assess your cat and give advice on weight, neutering and preventative care as required; these 20 minute appointments are free of charge and are scheduled for 6 months after the booster vaccination is given thus ensuring your pet has a thorough assessment every 6 months.

Rabbits:

Rabbits are vaccinated against Myxomatosis and Viral Haemorrhagic Diarrhoea (VHD). This consists of a course of 2 injections given 2 weeks apart. We advise 6 monthly boosters for Myxomatosis and yearly boosters for the VHD. Vaccinated rabbits can join our happy hopper club and receive 6 monthly assessments from the nurse free of charge.
