All prices are inclusive of VAT

Initial consultation (dog and cat)

(15minute allotted appointment time with a veterinary surgeon) £35:90

Follow up consultation (dog and cat)

(15minute allotted appointment time with a veterinary surgeon) £22:24

Consultations for other species are at varying rates.

The following vaccine prices are inclusive of the consultation fee

Dog vaccination course (puppy and adult dog course) £56:84

This includes a full clinical examination performed by a veterinary surgeon and a complimentary examination at 6 months of age (performed by a qualified nurse).

The vaccines we use give protection against Parvovirus, Leptospirosis, Infectious canine hepatitis, Distemper, Parainfluenza and coronavirus.

Puppies can be vaccinated from 6 weeks of age. The course includes 2 injections and the price is all inclusive.

Vaccinated puppies are given the option to join our puppy party course.

Free veterinary cover insurance is also offered for 4 weeks, at no obligation.

Dog vaccination booster (annual) £40:70

As well as a full health examination at the time of the vaccination, a complimentary health examination is offered 6 months after the booster.

Kitten vaccination course (kitten and adult cat course) £60:84

This includes a full clinical examination performed by a Veterinary surgeon and a complimentary examination at 6 months of age (performed by a qualified nurse).

The vaccines we use give protection against Flu, Feline infectious enteritis and Feline Leukaemia virus

Cat vaccination booster (annual) £44:27

As well as a full health examination at the time of the vaccination, a complimentary health examination is offered 6 months after the booster.

The following prices are for routine neutering.

They include:

- Full examination on admittance,
- Up to date anaesthetic agent (Rapinivet and Isoflurane),
- Antibiotic cover,
- Premedication including pain relief,
- Extensive continuous anaesthetic monitoring
- A dedicated nurse for post operative recovery and care
- An appointment for discharge and collection.
- A routine appointment and examination 2 days after surgery
- Suture removal 10 days after surgery.
- Weight check one month following surgery with nutritional advice if necessary
